

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

We are encouraging both health service providers and researchers to submit abstracts/proposals for the Conference. Interested individuals may submit one of two types of an abstract/proposals: (1) Research-based; (2) Practice-based. Submissions of no more than 500 words may be submitted via the online submission form.

Submissions should follow the following format:

- Title
- Session Objectives
- Approach
- Results (if applicable)
- Conclusions

For Practice/Clinical Submissions:

Practice-based submissions can include proposed, in-process, or completed innovative gerontological strategies, initiatives, projects, or research completed by providers working with older adults. Submissions must demonstrate a link to/consideration of research evidence.

For Academic Submissions:

Research-based submissions must explicitly link research to clinical practice either via the research methods employed, or by suggesting practice-based implications of the research findings.

Notes:

Please indicate if you are submitting for a poster, oral or workshop presentation in the form fields.

Submissions for oral and workshop presentations received after the submission deadline will not be accepted.

Submissions for poster presentations will continue to be accepted until the registration deadline.

All presenters must complete conference registration before their presentation will be formally included in the conference program. Failure to register for the conference will result in removal of the presentation from the conference. Conference registration fees are non-refundable.
